

We have reshaped aides for the sector and invested 21 million euros last year, in order to encourage the talent to express themselves.

The magic of moving pictures is their universality. We are convinced that culture should be accessible to all, throughout the region. Quality series, like the ones presented at the festival, can reach all audiences and touch all hearts. We are happy to stand shoulder to shoulder with you so that series can remain “works of art”.

We therefore wish you three vibrant days full of emotion, passion, magic, dreams and adventures. Great festival to one and all!






The series is told from the point of view of the family. We follow their journey, from accepting the money and starting a new life – to the family splintering and the father seeking vengeance for his son.





Since the early 2000s, Veerle has acted in numerous series, including European co-production *The Team*, French series *Beyond the Walls* and *Cordon* from Belgium. More recently she starred in *Tabula Rasa* (which had its first preview at Série Series 2017), a fantasy thriller which she also created. Veerle will share her experience as an actor but also as a writer and will unveil the new project she is developing, *Ghosts From the Past*, alongside its producers.



He has produced numerous feature films. Among them are titles such as *A Most Wanted Man* by Anton Corbijn and *Message from the King* by Fabrice du Welz. Using his extensive experience in the audiovisual sector, but also in entrepreneurship, he'll explain how he manages to bring together prestigious talents and pushes them to deliver their very best. He'll also share his vision of the sector, of the "recipes" to success and of power, the theme of this edition. The interview will be led by **Sydney Gallonde**, a French producer who has collaborated with other great fiction writers, including Harlan Coben and Guillaume Musso.

Whether it be in writing, on stage or on screen, humans are decidedly dependent on stories. However, that dependence runs deeper than we might think: it infiltrates every aspect of our lives and thoughts. We dream, fantasise and socialise through stories. Writer and researcher at the crossroads of arts and science, Jonathan Gottschall will immerse us into a dizzying world of thoughts on stories: why do we make them and how do they shape us?

DISCUSSIONS & ANALYSES

Throughout the three days, Série Series will be asking participants to analyse the industry's current trends and its challenges. Sessions focusing on two key European public broadcasters, France Télévisions and DR (Denmark), will allow for a more in-depth analysis of their methods as well as discovering their new series.



MARIA KYRIACOU CREATION AND INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Maria Kyriacou oversees all of the international production companies of the ITV group, the leading British production and distribution company, which is currently conquering the global market as well as spearheading international strategy in terms of drama. ITV Studios is

acquiring an increasing number of production companies, including some of the biggest in Europe. Maria will explain how she works hand in hand with the producers and talent in order to produce sophisticated and popular drama, which appeals to both a local and international market. The discussion will be held alongside two European producers from the group and will touch upon their collaboration and their vision of European creation.

THE AMPERE ANALYSIS MORNINGS

London-based research company Ampere Analysis, a new partner of Série Series, will open each of the three days with a 20 minute session analysing a theme linked to current events in the industry: international trends in series; the battle between VOD services and

traditional broadcasters; the strategies and methods of GAFAN. It will be a contextual analysis that will allow us to consciously delve into European creation.



FOCUS ON DR

Eighteen months ago, management for the drama section of the public Danish broadcaster was profoundly shaken up. How, amidst team changes and budget cuts, did the team led by Christian Rank renew and position itself? The entire team is coming to Fontainebleau and will share their vision of Danish and European drama and where they position themselves. They'll detail their strategy, the way they work with creators, in both tradition and online platforms,

and their way of relating to all audiences. They will also unveil three new series, with the creators in attendance: *When The Dust Settles*, *Deliver Us* and *A Family Matter*. It's an insight behind the scenes of a channel that has been a driving force of the resurgence and recognition of European drama with series like *Borgen* and *The Killing*, as well as a glimpse into a promising future.

FOCUS ON FRANCE TÉLÉVISIONS

A year after the restructuring of the group's drama department, the heads of national, international and digital drama will share their methods and current approach. They'll revisit the emphasis that is put on European collaborations and will present several new national

projects (*Romance*, *Une Belle Histoire*), digital projects (*Parlement*, *Mental*, *Stalk*) and projects developed following a recent alliance with the Rai and ZDF (*Leonardo*, *Mirage*), with the creative teams present.

AND AS ALWAYS THE BROADCASTER'S CONCLAVE

This meeting behind closed-door brings together the heads of drama of the major public and private European channels. It is an unparalleled, championed and exclusive session. Each year, they return prepared to discuss their respective challenges and questions.



SACD DEBATE: DRAMA IN EUROPE: A MODEL FOR FRANCE TO EMULATE?

Europe is a rich and diverse ground for series creation. Each year, it confirms its place as an increasingly dynamic and attractive hub. However, there is no unique European model. Whether it be in terms of financing, the role of government bodies, managing relations between writers and producers or the involvement of television

and digital platforms, the organisation of drama series depends on national or regional rationale. France is thinking of ways to set up a specific plan to support series and to homogenise new ways of organising creative work. However, it is still important to compare the practices set up in Europe with the current rules used in France.

SACD

SMALL BUDGET, BIG SUCCESS

Faced with the budget overkill of the platforms and international groups, how can one produce financially reasonable series, whilst still getting the best from the funds at hand but also the talent? Broadcasters, producers, creators and technicians will go over examples of controlled-cost series and will debate on financial efficiency and “local” drama.

AND THE NEXT GENERATION...?

Has the success of international platforms definitively caused a separation between 12-25 year olds and the traditional channels, or is this simply an opportunity for the latter to reinvent both their position and role towards millennials? How can we get closer to younger generations, their habits and perceptions? Broadcasters and creators will share their vision and their experiments in the matter. This discussion will highlight several recent initiatives and concrete examples, from genre series to ultra-realism.



SERIAL REMAKES

How to incorporate the original piece and give it a fresh impetus whilst also respecting its spirit and freedom?

A month after the broadcast of *Mouche* on CANAL +, writer and director Jeanne Herry, alongside producer Dominique Jubin and head of programming Pauline Morineau, will explain how she took on a mission which at first seemed impossible: creating a French

adaptation of *Fleabag*, a creation from screenwriter and actress Phoebe Waller-Bridge that couldn't possibly be more personal.

Unveiled during Série Series 2016, Flemish *Team Chocolat* has made waves in Europe, with several remakes in the pipeline. We will look at the Italian version with the creative team and representatives from the Rai.



CAFÉS SÉRIES

This year, the Cafés Series will be held on our brand-new open-air stage set up in the heart of the gardens of the Château de Fontainebleau. The Cafés Series are run as open and informal gatherings, that bring together professionals and the public at ‘apéritif’ time so that, together, they can discuss series, their role in our lives, their relation to society...

For this new edition, Série Series will work in association with Télérama and with the AAFA (French association of actors and actresses) to create informal and free-flowing discussions.

BACKING TALENT

Continuing its role as a pioneer, the event also backs creators with new project and has developed new initiatives to give a platform to new voices.



DISCOVERY

SPOTLIGHT ON TRAILERS BY SÉRIE SERIES

Launched in 2015, Spotlight on trailers by Série Series focuses on talent and creation. Série Series offers European creators who have a project for a series to create a trailer of less than 2 minutes to present it. About ten of these trailers are selected by the Série Series's editorial committee and screened before every session during the festival, as well as during a dedicated session, when the creators are invited to pitch their projects in front of the decision-makers attending the event.

In 2017, Série Series joined forces with La fabrique des formats, which will fund the development of two of the projects selected by the editorial committee to the tune of 50% of a pilot's budget, with an investment range between 25 000 and 75 000€. La fabrique des formats is an investment fund and a service company on the format market (surveys, training and expertise) for companies and professionals in the audiovisual and digital sectors.



FLASH PITCH WITH THE SACD

New this year: Série Series and the SACD have joined forces in order to shine a light on new talents, from diverse backgrounds, that have been spotted by associations and residencies supported by the SACD (1000 Visages, Atelier artistes en exil, La Cinéfabrique, La Résidence de la Femis, La Ruche, Talents en courts).

The Série Series editorial committee selects the talent based on their drama series project. These writers are invited to pitch a project in an original event format, inspired by talent shows, on the Fontainebleau Theatre stage. They will be coached by a director and introduced by a video profile. They will then have 1'30 to sell their project to the professionals in attendance!

SÉRIE SERIES OFF-SITE

Série Series is an open and vibrant event. It takes place year-round thanks to Off-site sessions in Europe and Africa.

Through this, Série Series participates in reinforcing the creative relationships between professionals from different European countries, but also between Africa and Europe.



SÉRIE SERIES AFRICA

Introduced in 2018, Série Series Africa is a biennial event modelled on Série Series and dedicated to pan-African series and those who create them. Pioneered by actor Issaka Sawadogo and Bénédicte Lesage, its first edition was held in February 2018 in Ouagadougou (Burkina Faso); the second will be held in February 2020.

Over three days, Série Series Africa offers screenings, case studies, project presentations, masterclasses, but also a selection of workshops aimed at writers, producers, actors and technicians involved in series creation. It's the perfect way to promote African creation and to connect African and European series creators.



SÉRIE SERIES OFF-SITE SESSIONS

Série Series is currently developing off-site sessions in order to shine a light on a particular country and to develop relationships with France in terms of series. Thanks to their reduced format (200 professionals, 1 to 2 days), these bilateral meetings stimulate the recognition of talent and the awareness of works, as well as facilitating the birth of new collaborations.



SÉRIE SERIES IN PARTNER FESTIVALS

Série Series also regularly organises off-site sessions in partner festivals across France and Europe. Off-site case studies and masterclasses “in the Série Series style” have thus been organised in professional international events such as the *Netherlands Film Festival* in Utrecht (2015, 2016, 2018), the *Nordic Series Days* in Oslo (2017), the *Nordiske Mediedager* in Bergen (2018), the *Marseille Web Fest* (2017), as well as in wider audience festivals like the *Festival de l'Histoire de l'Art* in Fontainebleau (2019) and *War on Screen* in Châlons-en-Champagne (2017).

SÉRIE SERIES KIDS

With Série Series Kids, children from 6 to 11 have their own festival. It is made up of a fun-filled and educational programme of screenings, talks with creators and workshops aimed at families and children from schools in the Île-de-France region. By developing a specific

section for children and a programme built around them, Série Series wants to give them the opportunity to have a different perspective on the animated series they watch, spark their creativity and sharpen their critical thinking.

With the support of the Région Île-de-France, Série Series continuously develops new ways to educate younger generations on the industry, along three axes:

- ▶ Discovering careers in the audiovisual sector, the courses that can be followed and what they can lead to.
- ▶ Analysing the creative process and what it technically requires (writing, directing, producing, acting...).
- ▶ Analysing series as a whole and developing a critical eye.

These intake shape via various off-site meetings organised by Série Series in local high schools, between series creators and the students.
